Clarification on different doubts that have arisen as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic:

1. This year, with the authorization of Tossa City Council and the local police, the access to Cala Salions will be controlled during office hours throughout the month of June. Reason for this is to have better control of the access to our beach and being able to perform all needed tasks to ensure maintenance of the facilities and meet sanitary and hygiene levels in the most efficient way.
2. Given the current Health situation, and the request coming from the City Council, we will need to avoid as much as possible people rotation in the apartments. Only those who have the mandatory tourist license will be able to rent. Those in possession of the license, must present the rental agreement to the office to inform about the duration and number of occupants of each apartment in each rental period.
3. Those notifications need to go via email/phone/WhatsApp to avoid any kind of manipulation. All the information will be posted on the website and visible on the office wall.
4. It would be highly appreciated if members who go to the office keep and respect safety and social distancing measures such as wearing a mask in closed spaces.
5. Job market: We are enabling a space on the Cala Salionç website where everyone can access and see job offers, as well as offer services. It is a good way to prioritize the hiring of people from La Cala to be able to help us all.
6. This year, access stickers will also not be mailed, so they should normally be given from the office as you come, or from the same barrier outside of business hours' office.
7. With regard to overdues, we invite all those residents who have outstanding fees to meet and find a solution that is favourable to all, so that it is not necessary to list anyone else in a report. We are all "salionists", we love our Cala, and we must seek a better coexistence. We suggest you look for ways to settle debts, considering account the situation of each person separately. Only those apartments that have not had the will to find a joint solution will be listed, which will lead us to initiate legal proceedings representing a cost for all.
8. Use of the beach during the month of June: small groups, respecting a 4 meters safety distance from each other. It will not be allowed to eat, play group sports or bring inflatables to the beach. This year, after the storm Gloria, the beach has been badly damaged. With the measures indicated by the City Council of Tossa, there is little room for everyone. Please prioritize the sand space for older people, and for those of you who are able to settle on the rocks until the second pier, please do so.
9. From July onward, we will evaluate the hiring of lifeguards and doctors. The bus service will be reactivated, complying with the corresponding security measures for



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this period. If anyone wants to candidate for these jobs, please contact the office and let them know so they can keep everyone in mind.

10. The Board ("Junta") proposes an Assembly date for the members on July 11. As soon as this date is definitive, we will send you the corresponding invite via email.

11. From the board, we are working to have the maximum information at all times, but the news are often contradictory and difficult to execute.

12. We thank all the partners for the trust placed in us. We have received many messages of support, and the truth is, this helps us a lot. We started the year with a devastating storm, Gloria, which left us without a beach. The storm that came after took down the bridge, knocked down trees, and took away the railing of the viewpoint, also causing damage to roads and other areas of the urbanization. And finally, a pandemic that has had us all isolated and with difficulties to solve from long distance the needs of the cala, but we will get out of this situation soon!!!
